

Theology of Worship

Course Description:

This course explores the subject of worship from a biblical perspective, emphasizing the major texts of the Old and New Testaments dealing with worship practices in Scripture. Current local church worship understanding and practice are explored in light of both Old and New Testament theologies of worship. The focus of the course is to train worship leaders in a thoroughly biblical understanding of the ministry of “spirit and truth” worship in the local church.

How to get enrolled in the course:

For the first course taken in the Graduate Certificate, there is a two-step process which includes (1) your *application* to the Graduate Certificate program (even if you are taking only a single course), and (2) your *registration* for the specific course. (After you have completed your application, this step is not necessary for subsequent registration in other courses in the certificate program.)

Application:

Contact Mrs. Laura Lawrence in the NOBTS Registrar’s office by sending an email to admiss@nobts.edu. In this email, please request an application form for the “Graduate Certificate in Worship Studies.” You should receive a response from the registrar which will include the 2-page application form and necessary information that is needed for your application, such as supporting documents, etc. This should be returned to the registrar office by the application due date in order to be eligible to enroll in the course.

Registration:

Once applications have been approved, registration is available for the course. Download the Academic Workshop Registration Form. Please note: the schedule for the workshop will be Tuesday, October 28 through Friday, October 31, 2008 (9AM until 5 PM each day.) Mail or fax this course registration form to the registrar’s office: 3939 Gentilly Blvd., New Orleans, LA 70126. Deadline for registration for this course is September 29, 2008. Cost:

There is a \$25 application fee due with application. The tuition for the course is \$170 per credit hour (\$510).
