Registration: Registration is done through the Leavell College office. Students may register as early as 90 days in advance. However, registration must be completed according to the scheduled deadline date for each workshop. Matriculation fees are required at the point of registration. Accounts do not have to be cleared for workshops, but students are required to pay course fees at registration unless other arrangements have been made through the Financial Aid Office. Tuition for Southern Baptist students is \$155 per semester hour (plus an additional \$5 per semester hour Undergraduate fee). Tuition for non-Southern Baptist students is \$255 per semester hour (plus an additional \$5 per semester hour Undergraduate fee). Tuition fees do not include meals or housing.
