Hurricane Preparation 101: Shelter in Place



Last week, Tropical Storm Claudette served as a tangible reminder that tropic systems can develop with little warning. If a tropical storm/hurricane develops as late as 12 hours before expected landfall in your area, evacuation becomes impossible. Each person in a hurricane-prone area should be working diligently to prepare a personal hurricane plan. But remember, an evacuation plan is not enough. You must also have a plan to stay put and ride out a storm if an evacuation becomes impossible.

Key items you will need to shelter in place

- 5-day supply of water per person
- 5-day supply of non-perishable food (canned food)
