All applicants: the following must be received by the ReDOC office for the application process to continue:

1. Application form complete with all supporting documentation (Statement of Call and Commitment, Ethical Conduct, Church Endorsement, Health Certificate, Proof of Immunization, 4 reference forms)
2. Application fee
3. Verification of GRE verbal, quantitative, and analytical writing scores
4. All official transcripts from colleges, universities, and seminaries (contact the ReDOC office concerning transcripts for courses in progress)
5. Written plan for completion of course prerequisites such as languages and hours in the major
6. Graded research paper from master's program
7. International students also must meet entrance requirements as outlined in the catalog under the section "International Students."

***October 5, 2009***

***March 22, 2010***

NOBTS applicants (local applicants) take the entrance examination.

Applicants should consult the chairperson of the division for information concerning the entrance examination as well as any other division requirements.

***October 15, 2009***

***March 25, 2010***

Non-NOBTS applicants (and nonlocal NOBTS applicants) take the entrance examination.
