- 5. Schedule EDOC9302 Educational Research Models and Methods (end of year 1)
- 6. Submit Research Proposal by the end of year 1.
- 7. Map your remaining seminars.

2 SENIOR RESIDENCY

- 1. Schedule and complete any remaining seminars.
- 2. Develop and Submit Your Prospectus
- 3. Continue your research and writing Prospectus.
 - a.*NOTE:* Stay in communication with your faculty mentor.
- 4. Submit a prospectus draft with an IRB application.
 - a. Proceed only after you have received final approval.
- 5. Apply for oral proficiency exam.



- 6. Submit your Final Prospectus with an IRB review to your faculty mentor and the EdD office.
- 7. Proceed only after you have received final approval from your Faculty Mentor
- 8. Schedule and complete the oral exam under the direction of your faculty mentor .

- 3. Complete research and writing DiPP.
