- Degree Completion at NGA:
 - Consult the latest edition of the Leavell College Undergraduate catalog for additional courses needed for degree completion.
 - NGA offers the Bachelors of Arts in Christian Ministry and two minors: Church Ministry and Psychology & Counseling. However, students may use several of the courses on the cycle to get a Biblical Studies or Pastoral Ministry minor with additional online classes.
 - Students may need to complete 18 hours of free electives through Academic workshops, online courses, and mentoring courses.
- Research and Writing and Senior Seminars: both Research and Writing and Senior Seminar are offered through Academic Workshops on the New Orleans Campus, Online every Fall and Spring semester, and every 3 years through CIV from NOLA to NGA.
 - Planning Suggestion: Students need to be aware that workshops and CIV courses have been cancelled because too few students enrolled. Therefore, it is our suggestion that students explore the online courses in their planning.

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- Research and Writing and Senior Seminars (continued):
 - Senior Seminar: Research and Writing is a prerequisite for Senior Seminar and a student must have completed 90 hours of their Bachelor degree to enroll.
- Computer Proficiency: Students will be required to demonstrate Computer Proficiency before taking an advanced computer course. Computer proficiency may be demonstrated through:
 - The completion of a high school course in which the student made a grade of B or above.
 - The transfer of an appropriate computer course from an accredited institution
 - The successful completion of the Leavell College Computer Proficiency Exam.
 - The completion of LSCM0360: Intro to Computers. LSCM0360 counts as a free elective and cannot be counted for the required math/computer elective in the General Education core.
- English Proficiency: Students will be required to demonstrate English Proficiency by:
 - The successful completion of the Leavell College English Proficiency Exam.
 - The completion of LSCM0310: English Grammar. English Grammar can only be counted as a Free Elective.
