1. Find your video on your channel. Go to YouTube.com and make sure you are signed-in with your @nobts.edu or @gmail account. Click the **Account Icon** > **YouTube Studio**

2. Click the **Videos** Icon on the left-hand side





6. Click **Course Content Items** and then click **Document**
