

Putt 4 Providence Contest Rules

Event Details: Putt 4 Providence is part of NOBTS & Leavell College's Spring Giving Days, taking place on **April 9 & 10, 2026**. The Putt 4 Providence putt-putt course will be located in the Fred Luter Jr. Student Center.

The event consists of three rounds:

- **Thursday, April 9: 9am – 1pm** (Round 1) and **1pm - 5pm** (Round 2)
- **Friday, April 10: 9am - 1pm** (Round 3)

Eligibility: Participants must make a gift to one of the following funds: Student Endowed Scholarship, Alumni Endowed Scholarship, or the Providence Fund, to play. Alternatively, participants can have a sponsor make a gift on their behalf.

Rules:

- **3-hole Course:** eligible participants play the par-9 course with the intention to do so in as few golf strokes as possible. There are three top places on the leaderboard for each round. In the case of a tie, the Longest Putt Challenge will be used to declare a round winner.
- **Longest Putt Challenge:** eligible participants get one putt each. Play is not dependant on completing the entire putt-putt course. Only holes-in-one will sign their names to the leaderboard.

Prizes:

- **3-hole Course:** Winners with the best scores will be chosen every 4 hours throughout the event. Those with the top three lowest scores will be given a trophy.
- **Longest Putt Challenge:** Winners will sign their name on the leaderboard.
